

Save time changing gullet bars on a saddle fit - use this handy tip to choosing the right size every time.

Every now and then you're presented with a horse whose wither is not so easy to judge by eye. Simply 'offer up' a SimaTree gullet bar to gauge the correct width. Allow the bar to rest on the horse's wither - this will give the best indication of which gullet bar to fit.



If the bar is too narrow, it will 'dive in' towards the horse's body and the bottom of the bar will dig in. A bar that is the correct width will follow the line of the horse's body perfectly. If the bar is too wide, it will 'flare out' away from the horse's body and create a gap at the bottom of the bar.
